



IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING BRAKE FLUID CHECKS!

It has come to our attention recently that most people are unaware of the importance of having their brake fluid checked. A quick check you can do yourself is to check your brake fluid level when the car is cold. If there is a sudden drop in fluid level you can assume there is a problem with the braking system and this should be checked by a professional as soon as possible.

For obvious reasons your brakes are one of the most important systems on a car, but unfortunately we assume everything is ok until it fails.

Did you know that for your brakes to work, your brake fluid has to remain incompressible up to 170 degrees C, the highest temperature created by your braking system. However, brake fluid does absorb water from the atmosphere which means under heavy braking the brake fluid could boil and lead to either spongy brakes or total brake failure! This would only normally happen in an emergency braking situation, not under normal use.

If you have your car serviced by us a brake fluid check would be included in a major service, however for any other service you would need to request a check. Prices vary from £33 incl for a basic small car, up to £120 incl for an executive car with abs brakes. Please call us on 544339 for a quote as some cars do cost more on.
