



NEW TYRES TO THE REAR

If you have been down to T.W. Tyres in the past five years or so, you have probably heard us say “put the new tyres to the rear” and the reasons for doing so. However if you have not had the pleasure of our advice, then let us explain why you should put your least worn tyres to the rear.

We are not going to blind you with science and use big technical words as it's really quite simple.

Irrelevant whether you have rear wheel drive or front wheel drive, it is a lot more difficult to assess the amount of grip you have on the rear tyres than on the front tyres, until you lose control. So if you have more tread on the rear you are more likely to have more grip. This is incredibly important in emergency situations for example having to do an emergency stop or misjudging a corner especially in wet conditions.

You will also find that you will get a higher mileage out of a set of tyres if you always put the best tyres to the rear. Obviously not good news for us but in this day and age of trying to be environmentally friendly we think it's sound advice.
