



WHAT'S IN YOUR CAR THIS WINTER?

Now that the nights are drawing in and the days are getting colder, are you prepared if you get stuck?

We have prepared a little check list of the things we recommend you keep in your car.

- Bottle of water
- Blanket
- Gloves and a woolly hat
- Shovel
- Torch
- De-icer and scraper, cloth to clean lights
- Adequate foot wear
- Enough fuel for the journey plus extra
- Warning triangle
- Mobile phone – with enough credit and charge
- Locking wheel nut, wheel brace and jack

We also recommend the following vehicle checks:

- Make sure your lights are clean
- Check all your engine levels
- Check your tyre pressures including the spare
- Most importantly check your anti-freeze

Why is anti-freeze so important.

During the colder winter months the wind chill factor that runs through your engine can be as cold as -30°C. Hence if your engine coolant does not have enough anti-freeze in it, it may freeze and damage your engine, resulting in a rather hefty bill. Here at T.W. Tyres and Autocentre we can check your anti-freeze free of charge. However, if it does need topping up then there is a charge. If in doubt call us or pop in.
